Enrollment Fee	Returning student	\$40 per enrollment	To cover a portion of the cost associated with continued enrollment in the preschool program	Student cannot re-enroll in preschool program
Classroom Fee	Classroom supplies	\$35 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of supplies that are expendable and consumable and/or items the school will retain after the class. This fee replaces school supply lists and parent purchased school supplies.	The required items and/or materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from the class or classroom activities if the fee is unpaid.
Classroom Fee	Consumable material	\$35 per year	To cover actual cost of consumable material used by the student in the classroom and/or are items students will retain after the class. Examples includes readers, t-shirts, workbooks, communication folders, planners, party supplies, etc.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Tuition	Preschool Tuition	\$260 per month	To cover a portion of the cost of operating the preschool program	Student cannot attend the preschool

Classroom Fee	Consumable material (Kindergarten)	\$35 per year	To cover class t-shirt, photo processing, holiday parties, Pos and Pizza, Mother's Day Makeover, Felix, 100th Day of school, technology platforms for learning.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid.
Classroom Fee	Consumable material (First Grade)	\$25 per year	To cover class t-shirt, holiday parties, 100th Day of School, homework folder, paper products, composition notebook, End of Year Economics Store, technology platforms for learning. Classroom Fee	Consumable material (Fifth Grade)	\$20 per year	To cover class t-shirt, holiday parties, planner, end of year ceremony, Scholastic New, classroom enrichment activities, technology platforms for learning.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip – See school website or field trip sponsor	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission and transportation. Fee is relative to cost of field trip.	A comparable alternative may be provided. With prior arrangement, a student who desires to participate in class field trip will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid.

Beginning in 2015-16, a student fee schedule specific to each school shall be posted to the school website in a prescribed location and shall be updated annually. Fees associated with a specific course shall also be included with the course description in the school's Course Guide. Only fees referenced and approved in procedure JQ-R may be levied.
